

BMHA Communication Protocol

Protests and Appeals

1. 24 hour respect rule. All parents, players, relatives and friends must adhere to the 24 Hour Respect Ryle by waiting a full 24 hours prior to contacting any Coaches, Managers or BMHA Representatives regarding any hockey concerns or issues.
2. Issues are to be addressed in the following manner: first to the Parent representative, if not than Coach or Manager. If no resolution is reached, then to the BMHA President, then to the BMHA Executive, each in their turn.
3. Any person, player, or team who disagrees with a decision of the BMHA, may lodge a written appeal with the Executive with seven (7) days of the decision of the incident in question.
4. The Disciplinary Committee will rule on any written protest or appeal within seven (7) days of receipt in writing. A written appeal may be presented to the Executive by making an appointment with the office.
5. The Executive members are to exclude any people who maybe in a conflict of interest on any matter for voting priviledges.
6. The decision of the BMHA Executive is final.
